### **INTRODUCTION**

Greenhill Well Drilling is a water well drilling business in Gouverneur, New York. Owner Mike Greenhill has a Mack rig tender truck with a crane on the back to pick up casing and drill rods.

### **THE CHALLENGE**

Greenhill had trouble depending on his previous crane during the three-year period he used it. Due to constant downtime, he would often lose three days of drilling when the crane broke down.

Additionally, the previous crane was electric over hydraulic, which was not an ideal configuration for his needs. Greenhill needed a new crane that was designed for his unique application with the hopes of eliminating downtime.
